

During 2020 Equinox piloted two open educational initiatives to support libraries as staff pivoted to working from home. These projects led to the launch of a new open educational program, equinoxEDU.

- 1) **Development of self-paced training resources for library staff adapting to remote work.** During May 2020, Equinox piloted a training video program with over 40 training videos. The training videos had 9,093 views and averaged 98 hours of viewing time per week over the course of the month.
- 2) **Dissemination of new educational resources online to support libraries as service models evolved.** With the development of the Curbside Pickup module, Equinox created open educational and training materials, including workflow documentation, instructor-led webinars, best practices for quarantine of library materials, and management of library closures and reopenings.

These initiatives culminated in the creation of **equinoxEDU**, a program that combines self-paced learning resources and instructor-led sessions to provide libraries with educational opportunities related to open source software and new technologies and standards. Resources include training videos, open webinar series, workshops, and resource guides.



DEVELOPING OPEN SOURCE TOOLS TO SUPPORT LIBRARIES DURING COVID-19

Equinox Open Library Initiative spearheaded the automation of curbside pickup functionality for Evergreen and Koha, offering libraries the option to manage curbside requests via the ILS, provide safe services to library users, and do so without incurring additional costs.
